 - Reviewed results of April 2017 neighborhood walk
 - Carrera Speed Study
 - May St/San Marco under construction – 2 yr. project/expected completion Fall 2019
 - Revamping parking system to see real time data @ garage and on street
 - 85% capacity at garage then city evaluate Park & Ride
 - 64% increase in Park & Ride
 - Parking analysis of city – next fiscal year review of policies
 - Commercial Loading zones – time restructure outside of peak hours
 - Tolomato Lot review – close off Spanish/If this is successful will look to remove Carrera St loading zone
 - Amending zoning for Residential parking system – grandfather in Saragossa & bay front
 - Residential hrs. 7a-7p
 - 60% of people on street need to sign and agree to get residential parking on street
 - Guest passes are 2 per year – will go to license plate system eventually
 - 2 public workshops available online
 - Carrera St. speed study – 85% - 26 mph or below – one week study
 - 20 mph blanket speed limit for neighborhood streets being considered. 90 day speed study on Carrera at 20 mph posted limit to determine if it works
 - Yellow portion of curbs completed
 - Oveido St to complete survey to eliminate parking on one side of street
 - Mobility website will have bike share program

 - Underground Utilities - overhaul would be on city dime not FPL
 - Historic Street lamps/signs to improve neighborhood
 - White box striping – can this be considered to make parking spots obvious – would be too costly for city at this time(man hours)
 - Yellow curbs – can they also put on “No Parking”
 - Cross walks at Cordova – need staff to complete project
